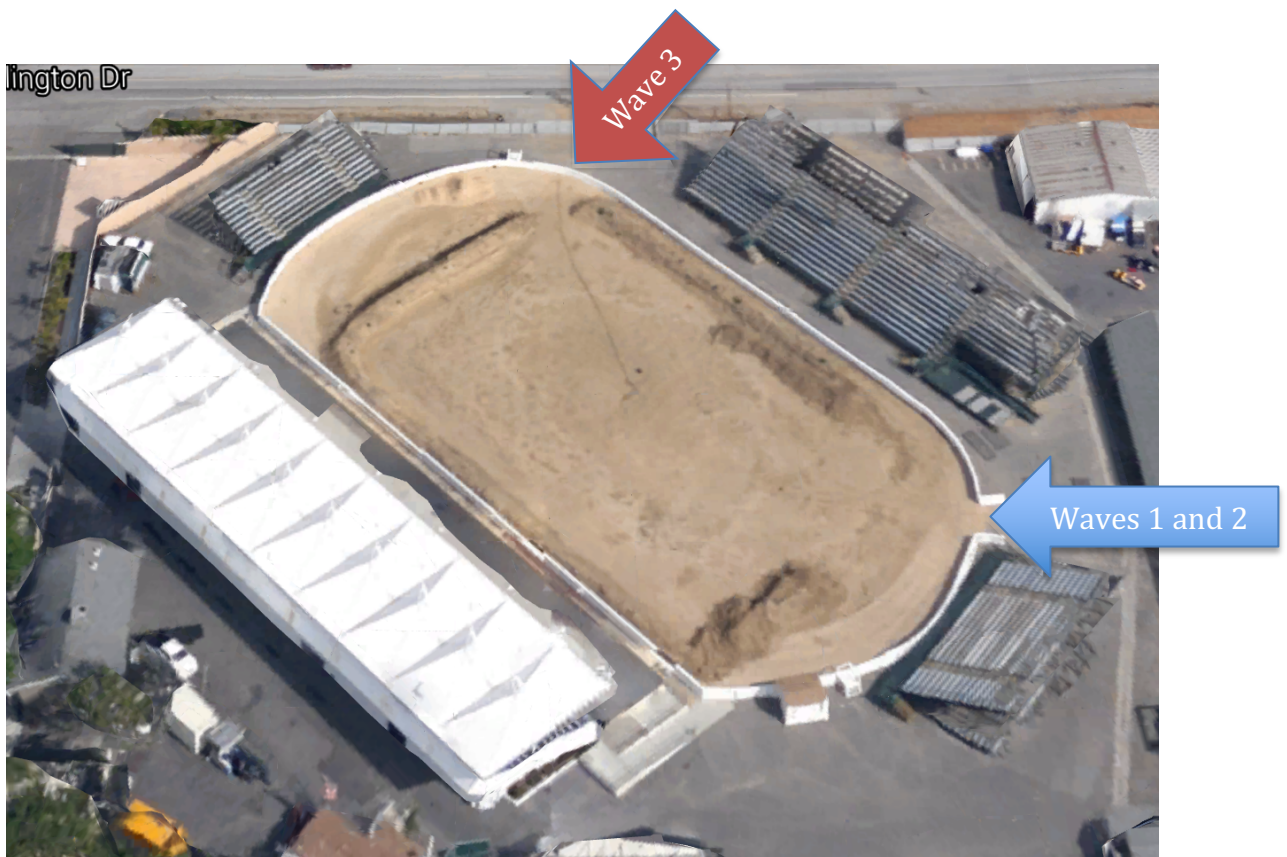


**2022 Costa Mesa Scottish Fest**  
**Pipe Band Instructions for the Opening Ceremony**  
**Saturday, May 28, 2022**  
**REVISION 1A**

**Formation Time: 11:45 AM at the main arena**

1. The pipe bands shall use two entrances.
  - a. Waves 1 and 2 will enter from the gate on the east end.
  - b. Wave 3 will enter from the northwest.
2. All waves will exit through the gate they entered.



When you arrive, please find your Leading Drum Major and wave assignment as shown below:

**Wave 1 will be 8 files across.**

**Waves 2 and 3 will be 7 files across.**

**Bass drums will be placed in the 7<sup>th</sup> rank.**

**LEAD TIP – All Wave 1 snare drummers will play the lead part in the full formation.**

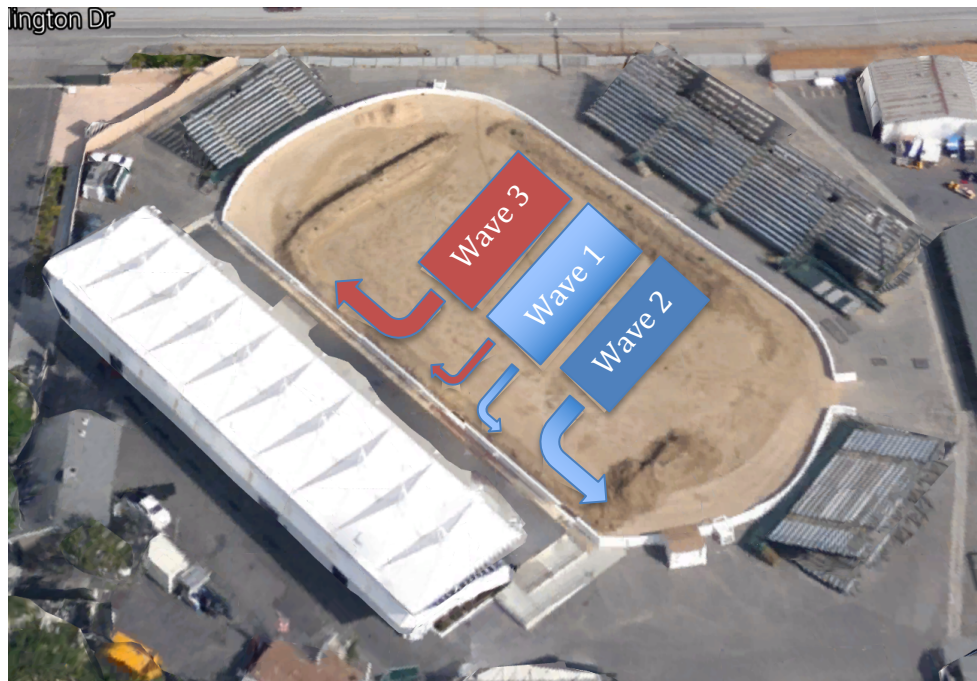
**\*NOTE: We will use the new ANAPBA drum scores.**

### 12:15 – Step Off

- Wave 1 play onto the arena with **Scotland the Brave/Rowan Tree** and take a position as the center band, halting and facing the audience. They will continue to play while the other waves march on.
- Waves 2 and 3 will march in synchronized, with pipes up but not playing, to take a position as bookends to Wave 1.
  - Drum Majors: Step off when Wave 1 begins their countermarch.



- **Massed P&D will perform BONNIE DUNDEE (two countermarches and halt).**
- Introduction of Chieftain / Declare the games open
- **Massed P&D will play HIGHLAND LADDIE (Moving, 2 countermarches).**
- LA Scots and 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine will march on.
- **Everyone will play AMAZING GRACE (solo / 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine & LA / Massed P&D).**
- LA Scots & 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine will play America the Beautiful.
- **Massed P&D will play SCOTLAND THE BRAVE once through (At the Halt).**
- LA Scots & 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine will exit.
- **Massed P&D will play GREEN HILLS/BATTLE'S OVER and start their exit:**
  - a. All three waves will play the 1<sup>st</sup> part of Green Hills at the halt.
  - b. Waves 2 and 3 will start marching forward on the 2<sup>nd</sup> part of Green Hills. They will go forward onto the track and wheel outward toward the gate they entered.
  - c. Wave 1 will step off on the start of Battle's Over, split, and follow the other waves out. The right half will follow DMaj Colleen Wilson. The left half will follow DMaj Kevin Conquest.
  - d. Drum Majors - Take your bands through the gate as far into the setup area as possible before cutting off.

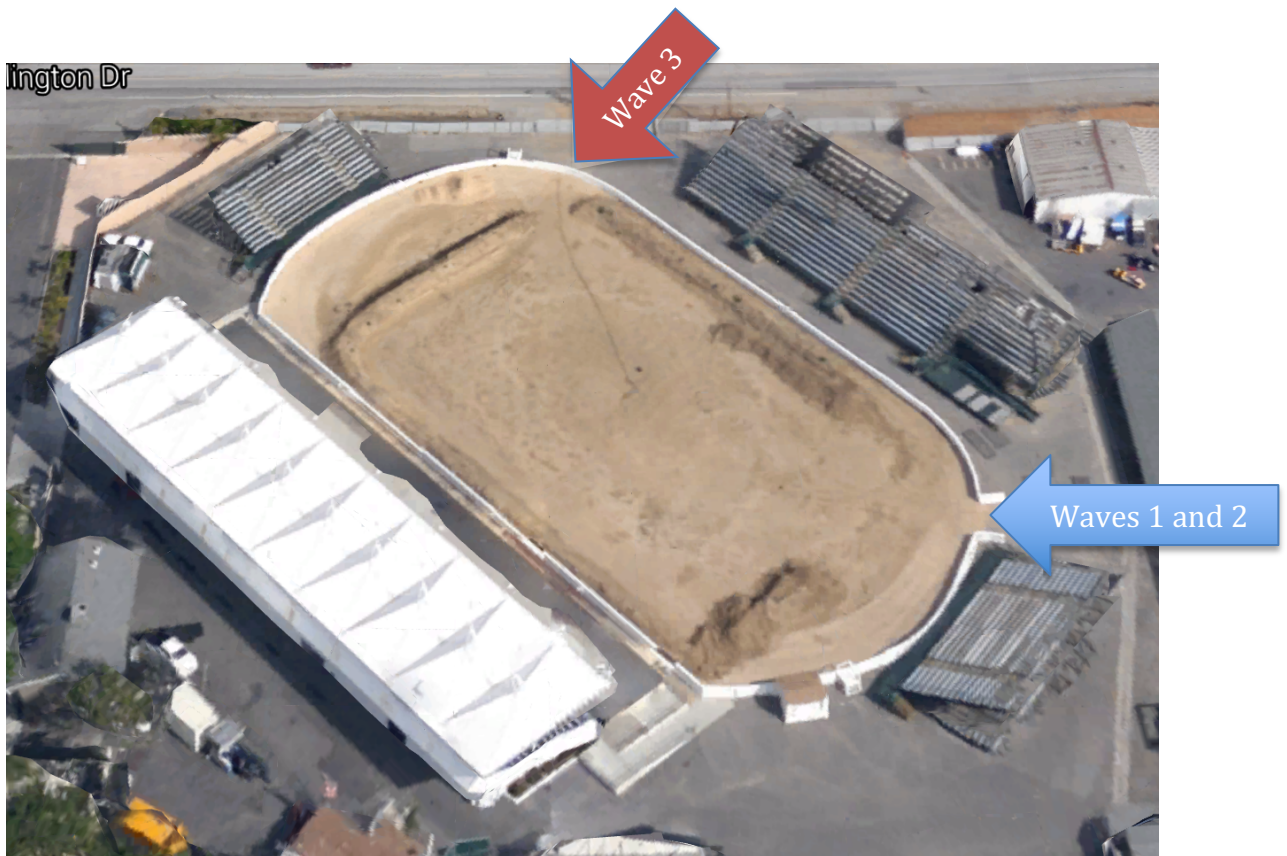

**Sunday, May 29, 2022**  
**REVISION 1A**

**Formation Time: 4:40 PM at the main arena**

1. The pipe bands shall use two entrances.
  - a. Waves 1 and 2 will enter from the gate on the east end.
  - b. Wave 3 will enter from the northwest.
2. All waves will exit through the gate they entered.



When you arrive, please find your Leading Drum Major and wave assignment as shown below:

**Waves 2 and 3 will be 7 files across.**

**Bass drums will be placed in the 7<sup>th</sup> rank.**

**LEAD TIP – All Wave 1 snare drummers will play the lead part in the full formation.**

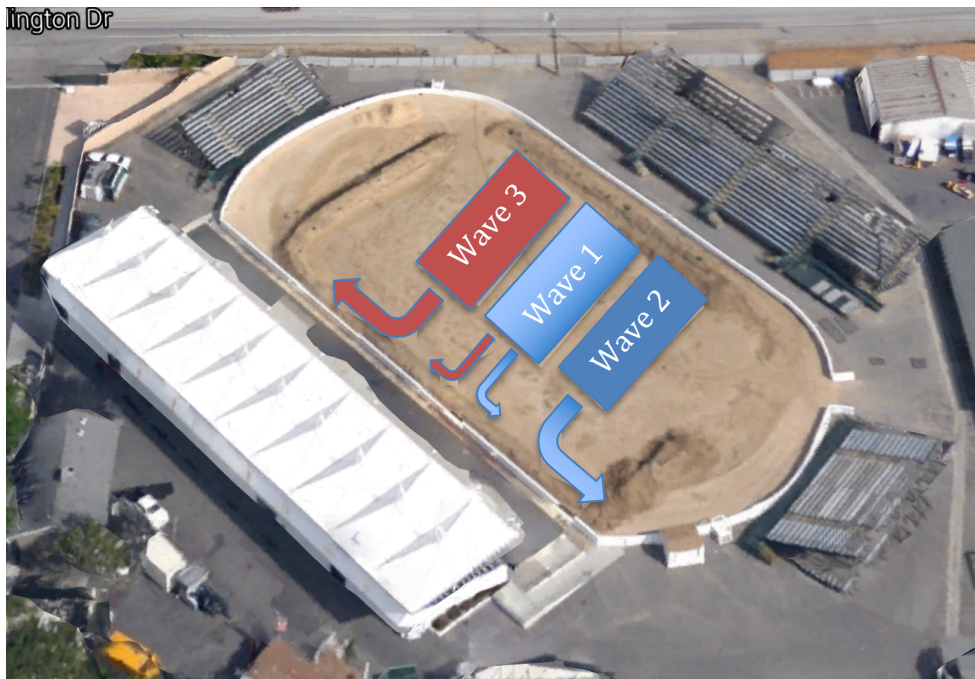
**\*NOTE: We will use the new ANAPBA drum scores.**

### 5 PM – Step Off

- Wave 1 play onto the arena with **Scotland the Brave/Rowan Tree** and take a position as the center band, halting and facing the audience. They will continue to play while the other waves march on.
- Waves 2 and 3 will march in synchronized, with pipes up but not playing, to take a position as bookends to Wave 1.
  - Drum Majors: Step off when Wave 1 begins their countermarch.



- LA Scots and 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine will march on.
- **Everyone will play AMAZING GRACE** (solo / 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine & LA / **Massed P&D**).
- Prizes will be awarded.
- **Massed P&D will play SCOTLAND THE BRAVE once through (At the Halt).**
- LA Scots & 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine will play Auld Lang Syne.
- LA Scots & 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine will exit.
- **Massed P&D will play GREEN HILLS/BATTLE'S OVER and start their exit:**
  - a. All three waves will play the 1<sup>st</sup> part of Green Hills at the halt.
  - b. Waves 2 and 3 will start marching forward on the 2<sup>nd</sup> part of Green Hills. They will go forward onto the track and wheel outward toward the gate they entered.
  - c. Wave 1 will step off on the start of Battle's Over, split, and follow the other waves out. The right half will follow DMaj Colleen Wilson. The left half will follow DMaj Kevin Conquest.
  - d. Drum Majors – Take your bands through the gate as far into the setup area as possible before cutting off.
